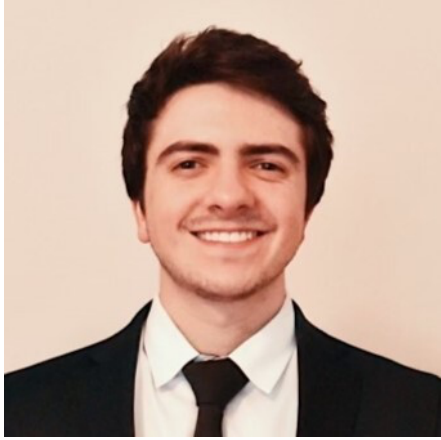


MAURICIO GARCIA ONTANON
