Lifetime Achievement Award

I. Profile of Nominating Committee

- Shall operate as an *ad hoc* committee.
- Nominating Committee should be selected by the Chair Elect with input from the Officers and Council Members as the Chair Elect deems appropriate
- The Nominating Committee should consist of at least five (5) members.
- The Nominating Committee should be representative of the geographic, practice and other diversity of the Section members.

II. Criteria for Award

- The Recipient shall be selected by the Nominating Committee.
- The Nominating Committee should solicit recommendations from the Officers and Council Members.
- The award shall be awarded to an individual who is living or who passed away within the preceding year.
- The Recipient should have practiced law, or otherwise been involved with intellectual property law, for a minimum of 25 years.
- The Recipient's career should have had a significant impact on the intellectual property law practice in Texas.
- The Recipient should preferably be a long-time member of the IP Section.
- The award shall be considered annually, but not necessarily awarded annually.
